



Vernon J. Baker Educator's Trust Scholarship

At least one scholarship will be presented to a graduating Clarinda High School senior from the Clarinda High School Scholarship Fund. Scholarship(s) will be in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500), with the number of scholarships given to be determined by the amount in the fund as of May 1 each year.

The following guidelines will be used in making the scholarship selection:

1. The applicant must have a cumulative grade-point average of 3.25.
2. The applicant must show evidence of serve to the school and community through involvement in several activities.
3. Financial need is **not** a prerequisite.
4. A screening committee of three (3) high school faculty members and two (2) underclassmen appointed by the high school counselor will select three (3) finalists from those students submitting applications. **NOTE:** In the event that more than one scholarship is given, the committee will select five (5) finalists.
5. the final section(s) will be by vote of the entire high school faculty.
6. Application and responses must be typed or computer generated.
7. The scholarship shall be awarded without regard to race, color, creed, gender, national original or physical handicap.
