Ralph and Gladys Borden Memorial Scholarship (*\$1500.00, renewable for three additional years; amount varies per year.*)

This scholarship is available to high school graduates living in the former New Market School District. (Contact the Clarinda Foundation Office for a legal map of former district). The amount of this scholarship varies from year to year, but is renewable for three additional years.

Ethel Brockman Nursing Scholarship (*\$500.00*)

This scholarship is available for a Clarinda or South Page high school senior planning to pursue further education in the field of nursing

Robert & Irene Renshaw College Scholarship (*\$2,000.00 for the 2011-2012 school year*)

Bob and Irene Renshaw continue the strong interest in education, which they showed during the many years as active Clarinda Schools supporters. Bob was a graduate of Clarinda High and an outstanding athlete. Irene taught in Clarinda schools for many years.

This scholarship is available to a Clarinda High School graduating senior planning to major in education at a four-year college or university.

Robert and Irene Renshaw Vocational Scholarship (*\$1,000.00 for 2011-2012 school year*)
